
### Complying Superannuation Fund Notice

FirstChoice Employer Super, FirstChoice Wholesale Personal Super and Total Care Plan Super are part of the Colonial First State FirstChoice Superannuation Trust ('the Fund'). The Fund is a complying, resident, regulated superannuation fund within the meaning of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 and is constituted under a trust deed dated 29 April 1998.

The trustee of the Fund is Avanteos Investments Limited ('the trustee'). In the event that the Fund's complying status were revoked the trustee would receive notice to that effect under section 63 of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act. The trustee confirms that it has not received nor does it expect to receive any such notice.

Pursuant to section 25 of the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992 (the SG Act), a contribution made by an employer for the benefit of the employee to one of the above funds is conclusively presumed to be a contribution to a complying superannuation fund if the employer receives this Complying Superannuation Fund Notice at or before the time that the contribution is made, except in the limited circumstances set out in that section.
